

NOTIFICATION

Dear Patrons and friends of
Salon Music, Gauteng Philharmonic Orchestra and Brooklyn Theatre.

18 March 2020

The following notification forthwith refers to the above-mentioned concerns as Brooklyn Theatre.

In preparation for the current situation regarding The Coronavirus, alternatively called COVID-19, Brooklyn Theatre already sent a notification to Brooklyn Theatre supporters and artists regarding the hygienic precautions at Brooklyn Theatre on 12 March.

In the light of the President's speech of 15 March, prohibiting public gatherings of no more than 100 people, Brooklyn Theatre was prepared to stick to the legal limit and go ahead with concerts. In the last few days, after numbers of infections increased considerably, Brooklyn Theatre consulted with the theatre's Medical Advisory Team, and decided on the following:

The health and well being of the Brooklyn Theatre's supporters, artists and fellow South Africans are of prime importance to us. Brooklyn Theatre therefore feels morally obliged to cancel public gatherings completely until 30 April.
